Specific

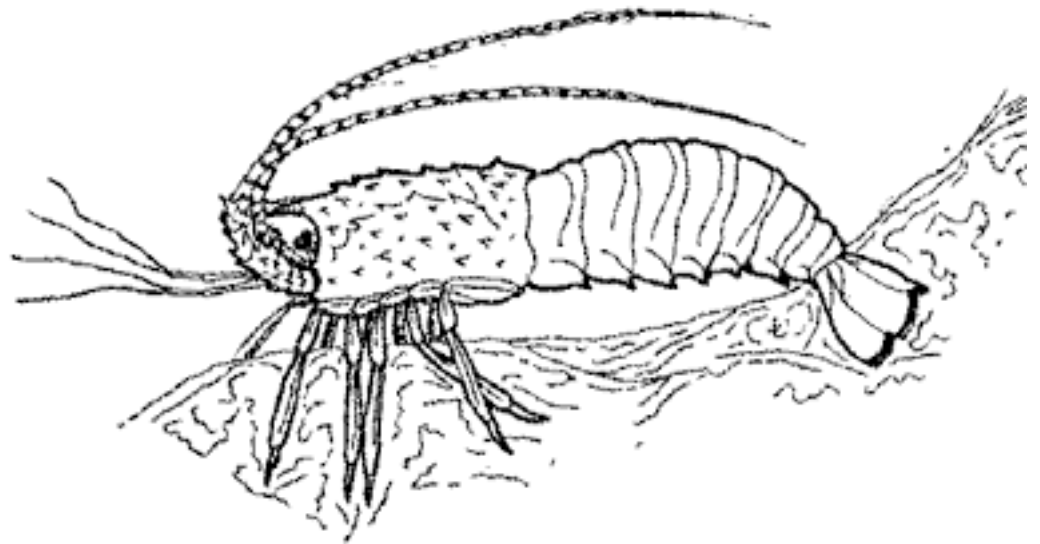
Expectations
